

Stage One Evaluation

Members of the Voices for Tasmanian Youth Consultative Council were invited to complete an anonymous evaluation of the first stage of this project. Of 19 members, 12 respondents took up this invitation, completing a survey through MS Forms. The 10 questions below were posed using a Likert scale to gauge levels of agreement. Two additional free text questions, not presented below, were also posed.

As with all feedback CCYP receives, this information will support the continuous improvement of future engagements with children and young people.
