We want to hear from you about your views and ideas for how this new team should work and we will make sure the Government knows what you have to say.

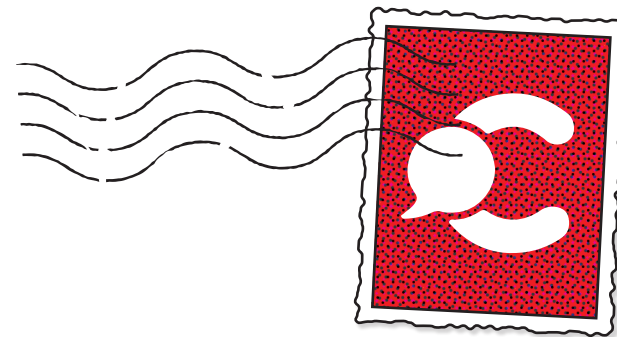
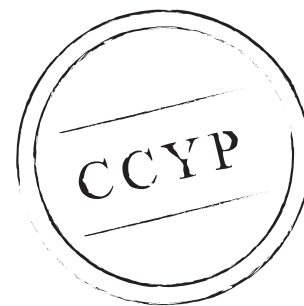
